

Installing Custom Language File in HUGIN

When HUGIN is run, the program checks for the presence of a folder in the <HUGIN-install-dir> named 'i18n'. If this directory is found and it contains any xml-files, these files will be presented as an option in the language selection of the preferences dialog inside HUGIN.

Thus to install a custom language file, first create the 'i18n' directory:

<HUGIN-install-dir>\i18n

e.g.: C:\Program Files(x86)\Hugin Expert\Hugin Developer 7.5\i18n

Now place a well formed XML file containing HUGIN string constants in the directory:

<HUGIN-install-dir>\i18n\<language>.xml

e.g.: C:\Program Files(x86)\Hugin Expert\Hugin Developer 7.5\i18n\mylanguage.xml
